

Meeting Commenced at 6:03PM

Treasurer's Winter Warm Up Report shared – working on collecting remaining funds from ticket sales

- Spreadsheet presented needs editing (BSH, Barryville Exterminating 2X)
- Dorene let us know a check was in the mail and will follow up on a few items, Cathy will follow up on a \$90 donation
- A couple of items received on 3/11 have not yet been added to the spreadsheet
- Cathy has all silent auction forms and what each item went for- she will create spreadsheet to share out
- Very few items didn't sell, those that were left/not bid on were and will be returned
- Two new memberships forms were submitted
- Balance to date shared: \$11,316.50
- Bills outstanding \$111.00 1 expense, 1 reimbursement (print shop) checks will be issued
- Everything else cleared and paid
- Accounts for last year seeking outstanding items
- 1 uncashed check from WWU 2018 will be reissued she will make final updates tonight and reissue
- Meeting minute correction GBCC wants to extend a courtesy of attending WWU to applicants families as we have done in the past

Meeting this Thursday 3/14 with co-treasurer – open to anyone to come (5PM, location tbd)

- Chamber may want to use Quickbooks can pull bank info
- Treasurer has been using Intuit; not a perfect system. Comment that it was buggy; uses it mostly for P & L reports, for Invoicing it is a bit easier; further discussion down the line is needed (\$21.60/month) – Chamber suggested reimbursement for this system and the out of pocket costs
- Meg's Recommendation GBCC needs to get a more clear picture of what we need (Ren. Initiative needs to be its own account – grants; Scholarship should be a different account; Gen. Operating account – all need to be allocated separately
- Did reach out to Anna about NPO options (scholarship through Wayne bank)
- This was a well received idea (example past scholar, didn't receive scholarship \$ didn't go to college maybe create a policy around this with limitations of when you can get the funding
- Sign Grants we paid out \$4,000.00 already and some is going to the Butterfly sign and line item (est. \$300)
- Meeting Minute Correction/Addition: Money for the signs is part of a 3 part grant
 GBCC Debit/Credit Cards
 - We have 1 Debit, \$500 daily limit in Ed's name proposed to close it and proposing we no longer use anyone else's personal cards for purchases....
 - Motion that Co VP each get one with a \$1,000.00 limit; No ATM withdrawal access on these cards; Motion – Roswell wants to know what pre-approval is needed; Meg watches this and she can list expenses each month in an expense report addendum; Motion Seconded & Approved 6:22PM



 Account signers – Meg will bring signature cards with her on the next meeting – Co-Treasurers need to be added, total signers – Roswell, Anna, and removing Ed – Can put as many as we want but require two signers; Motion Seconded and Approved 6:34PM

Questions about area/town sign grants:

- We paid in full to Nicole \$4200 etc.. (Triangle sign)
- Signage group/committee needs to meet
- \$1,200 for large sign near Carriage House / Reber
- \$500 for additional sign/hardware a total of \$3600 is needed we can cover that right now
- We are waiting on \$7500 to come in from Sullivan Renaissance to replace the billboard, map, welcome banners and 2 historic signs (Deb); need to meet on welcome banners

Membership

- We do need to financially clarify and add to the membership form (Ex we get new membership from vendors each year near pumpkin fest – and the timing is weird for annual funds/reporting and communication
- Can we try to get the date of renewal earlier this year? We aren't hitting verified members and they are benefiting from marketing without really paying for a full year
- Marketing timeline needs to be developed a recommendation March is a tough for small businesses; slow transition new January members
- There is some who pay early; Back date by last year's payment date and send bills
- Idea of thinking bigger in terms of Membership Drive
- Johnny will be on Membership committee Claudia mentions we should reach out and welcome new businesses that are in our zip code coverage she will look into that
- Comment Dorene: How do we encourage payment of invoices; Meg suggested creating a prorated system

Winter Warm Up Feedback:

- Two buffet lines needed next year
- Thank you notes Marie will take care of the donations she secured; GBCC asks all those who secured donations to send thanks using the provided materials Dorene shared via email (letter template, envelope template)
- Cathy will create a list of all donations received

- Should we provide that feedback to CMR? Rule of no competing business vendors selling wares (jewelry stand confused guests)

- Goal that each banner has an artist represented on both sides; we feature the artists on our website (welcoming, showcase) – Request that Claudia help create a call to artists? Outreach support and help judge/selection committee
- Engage school; art teachers; opening night or party and a print of each banner to sell as a financial avenue to keep the program going from year to year (can't rely on grants) and should there be business sponsorship (group needs to pick a date)
- Date to meet to talk about size, material, vendor, rules for engagement
- All info needs to be packaged and decided upon before the next GBCC meeting

New Business:

- Confirmation of move this week (Barryville Farmers Market) JP contacted Greg and took him around to all viable spots after much work to secure; Decision was ultimately made to move to Narrowsburg
- Farmers Market lost the space outside of River Market for 2019 and beyond
- JP and Farmers Market both posted the notice and information to Facebook lots of outcry, comments, people really want to have a Farmer's Market in the area
- Goshen Farmers Market was contacted by JP to just start a discussion about new opportunities; Goshen Chamber excited to talk to GBCC and build a relationship
- Offered an in kind membership to Goshen Chamber for GBCC Suggestions on what to do from Goshen include
 - Retain the market name, dev a committee to manage it; have it live on our website and/or as concerned citizens we can start a separate 501c3
 - Methodist church could be a potential site
 - Park at church and areas btwn Debs house and high point (double access homes) would be blocked off and traffic would go in both directions
 - O Deb contacted Nadia to see if we could section it off; got approval
 - O Church & Bizcheck wants to join in on the FM planning and add a thrift shop; seek donations; flea market
- Sullivan Renaissance interns to help direct traffic
- New Hope has residents who attend church could support efforts
- Corrections officer who can help get us support to clean-up afterward



Question posted - what should GBCC do at this point?

- Establish a new group of people who would manage this; they'd have to be or become member
- Residents have already offered to help with adjudication, vendors, etc....
- Needs to be rules/regulations to prevent liability issues, insurance policies to support the effort
- Well received idea that GBCC support in the creation of a 501c3 for this effort and foster the development and organization of a new market
- Mention that the Lackawaxen Food Hub closing too
- Ideas posited to use market and new space as an activation opportunity; craft fair; River Walks; healthy community initiatives
- GBCC will need to craft a statement for what is to come for the public
- JP is compiling lists of vendors, farmers if anyone has ideas on vendors send to Johnny P.
- Well received idea to join the Goshen Chamber of Commerce

New Project - Healthy Community Initiative with support of Sullivan 180

- Cathy Sullivan 180 (Mrs. Gonzalez) was contacted and they want to expand into our area; Highland Lions Club (and all other clubs, Can't Hurt Steel) help out with creating a health fair
- Lots of support from Ms. Saraid Gonzalez, Community Outreach and Events Manager for the area (suggested locations school or senior center on route 55)

Friday night Sullivan 180 will come to the Lion's Club meeting in April

- Ask all GBCC members to be an exhibitor
- July/August execution of event
- Volunteer, outreach to members, promote GBCC's role in the initiative
- Cathy will find out how many exhibitors they are requesting
